Meeting Summary

Welcome:

Dr. Jeannie Davis welcomed everyone to the meeting and led introductions.

There was no Early Learning Hub presentation, due to a death in the family.

BMI Data:

JoAnn Miller presented the Samaritan Health Services (SHS) Adult BMI Report – All patients ages 20-65 with an encounter in 2022 (For Benton, Lincoln, and Linn Counties) and the SHS Pediatric BMI Report – All patients ages 2 to 19 with an encounter in 2022 (For Benton, Lincoln, and Linn Counties).

- At the last meeting, we talked about looking at the BMI data for Linn, Benton, and Lincoln Counties for any improvements or changes.
- Reviewed data included in the agenda for 2-19-year-olds.
- JoAnn Miller described how the data is collected.
- Reviewed Adult data regarding BMI and comparison among the 3-county region.
- How can we integrate this information into a topic for the Summit?
 - a. Cooking a recipe.
 - b. Doctor discussion
- JoAnn Miller shared about a nutrition grant [Gus Shumacher](#) through USDA if any community partners are interested in applying.
- How do we bring more healthy/nutritious programs to the community?
- How can we look at obesity more comprehensively? Not just “healthy eating” as the only solution including mental health, physical health, and the intersectionality of other factors, etc.?
- There was discussion around how to return the cooking classes to the community, especially for youth because they are so popular among the youth. Many classes have been disrupted due to COVID restrictions and have resumed.

2023 Summit:

Discussion focused on the 2022 Summit.

- Date - August 25, 2023
- Focus - Youth/Youth Health including nutrition and mental health
- Format - Hybrid is what we have been planning, but we should revisit the in-person only option. *A vote was taken, and the majority voted for in-person option only.*
- Location - To Be Determined due to lack of hybrid capabilities at the Center for Health Education (CHE) - only 1 camera and now the group has decided to move forward with no remote option.

- a. LBCC Chinook Benton Hall - Since we know that they will support our tech needs. Dr. Jeannie Davis emailed Toni Morrison regarding the availability of LBCC on August 25, 2023; Toni Morrison replied that the site is available August 25, 2023.
- b. Oregon Coast Community College (OCCC) - Jolynn Meza Wynkoop will be at Oregon Coast Community College in the upcoming week and will assess the lay out of the community room and other classrooms to be used for the breakout sessions.
- c. Performing Arts Center at the Coast - *Dr. Jeannie Davis will reach out to Randy Storms from the Performing Arts Center regarding their availability on August 25, 2023.*
- Catering - To Be Determined – We won't be able to decide until a location has been determined; it was recognized that the coast has limited catering options and since COVID restrictions, Side Door Café has increased their rates and last reported weren't catering.
- Funding - Discussion around funding options for the summit, including the catering; the discussion will continue as new grants could be an option.
- Title - One suggestion that seemed to resonate with the group: *“Whole Person Approach to Health.”*
- Breakout topics- 45 minutes – 1 hour for each session:
 - a. Parental Support
 - b. Nutrition/Physical Health Education
 - c. Mental Wellbeing
 - d. Youth Services
 - e. One session in Spanish - Luis Acosta is working with parent of teens right now and will assess the needs in the Hispanic/Latino community
