Adult emergency voucher program

Made possible by Samaritan Health Services and the Linn County Oral Health Coalition, eligible community members can receive vouchers for emergency dental care through participating dental providers. Interested participants must be screened. If they qualify, they will receive a voucher and an appointment with a participating provider.

Eligibility requirements:

- Resident of Brownsville, Lebanon or Sweet Home area
- Uninsured
- Low income
- 19 years of age or older
- Experiencing dental pain

Dental van program

Made possible by Samaritan Health Services, Linn County and Regional Oral Health coalitions, and in partnership with Medical Teams International, dental vans staffed with volunteer dentists and hygienists, provide no-cost dental care once per month in east Linn County.

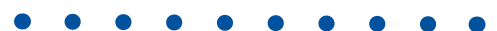
