

A safe and healing environment

At Sarah's Place, we recognize our collective responsibility to provide a safe haven for anyone needing immediate medical treatment from sexual violence, domestic violence and non-fatal strangulation.

Sarah's Place provides a safe place for patients to receive resources and inclusive care, regardless of age, race, gender identity or sexual orientation.

As the first sexual assault nurse examiner (SANE) center in Oregon, Sarah's Place was established in 2016. Sarah's Place is located inside the hospital, but away from the Emergency Department, to allow direct and immediate access for patients.

Sarah's Place has safe, private exam rooms, consultation rooms for patients and families and a private shower.

Staffed by SANE nurses with specialized training, Sarah's Place is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, to provide free medical and forensic care, community resources and additional support.

SANE nurses are also available on the coast, in the Emergency Departments at Samaritan North Lincoln Hospital and Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital.
