Welcome:

Shelagh Baird welcomed everyone to the meeting and led introductions.

Meeting Minutes:

The April 9, 2024, meeting minutes of Linn, Benton, Lincoln Partners for Health were presented. Sommer McLeish noted on page 1 of the meeting minutes under the Violence Prevention Summit part – The Summit will be held at Samaritan Lebanon Community Hospital. **Sommer McLeish made a motion and Jolynn Meza Wynkoop seconded to approve the meeting minutes with the noted change. The motion was voted upon and was unanimously approved.**

Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Grant - Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities:

Sommer McLeish reported on the Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities Grant.

- The Strangulation Training was held on May 3, 2024, at Boulder Falls Conference Center in Lebanon. There were 98 people who signed up for the event and there were 74 in attendance.
- The Violence Prevention Summit is scheduled for May 17, 2024.
 - a. The Summit will start at 8:30 a.m. with breakfast and training starting at 9:00 a.m. and going until 3:00 p.m. and will be held at Samaritan Lebanon Community Hospital.
 - b. The keynote speaker is Rebecca Bender.
 - c. AHM Brands out of Eugene will be there at the start of the summit. They are helping with the Marketing campaign and will discuss and gather information.
- Lincoln County – Luis Acosta has been holding three forums for mam speakers and will add an additional one on May 23, 2024. He is helping them complete a survey.
- Working with ABC House (direct services) and CARDV (navigation services) and working to get curriculum in the middle and high schools.
- Tami Speten is the new contact for ABC House. Glenda Lonstron is leaving.
- We have our TAs/HRSA reps that will be visiting us May 15-17, 2024. They will be touring the ABC House tomorrow. Will also be touring Sarah's Place. We want them to see community partners we work with.

Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities Grant – Evaluation Plan:

Dr. Paulina Kaiser discussed the Evaluation Plan for the Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities Grant. She noted that she is Director of the Outcomes-Research for Samaritan Health Services and works as Evaluator on different grants.

- **Key Details:**
 - a. The evaluation is due June 28, 2024.

- b. Components:
 - Logic model
 - Evaluation questions (*from proposal*)
 - Evaluation work plan (*partially from proposal*)
 - Data dashboard (2-3 measures to be tracked annually)
- **Evaluation questions and workplan:**
 - a. Project Goal 1: Strengthen and sustain regional Partners for Health (PFH) network to enhance capacity to address domestic violence and child abuse prevention and support services in Lincoln and east Linn Counties.
 - Evaluation questions, data sources, and evaluation methods were shared.
 - b. Project Goal 2: Increase knowledge around child abuse, domestic violence, and human trafficking through outreach and education in Lincoln and East Linn Counties.
 - Shared Evaluation questions, data sources, and evaluation methods.
 - c. Project Goal 3: Expand access to services that address child abuse and neglect, domestic violence, and human trafficking in East Linn and Lincoln Counties by June 30, 2027.
 - Shared Evaluation questions, data sources, and evaluation methods.
 - d. Project Goal 4: Sustain activities and services of CCCWN/PFH that address child abuse and neglect, domestic violence, and human trafficking through comprehensive planning for Lincoln and East Linn by June 30, 2027.
 - Shared Evaluation questions, data sources, and evaluation methods.
- Shared a template for the Evaluation Plan Work Plan.
- **Data Dashboard:**
 - a. Data Dashboard Report #1 due June 28, 2024, covering data from 7/1/2023-5/30/2024.
 - b. Include 2-3 measures that grantees deem most important to track on a routine basis to guide the successful implementation of the program as well as the successful operation of the network.
 - c. Include 2-3 measures. Shared the template:
 - List measure (more detail helpful to reader).
 - Describe the measure.
 - Start date for monitoring this measure.
 - Measure status as of start date.
 - Measure status for most current data entered.
 - Desired status/goal for this measure.
 - Trend direction between start and current.
 - Desired trend direction for measure.
- **Dashboard measure options:**
 - a. # people receiving grant-funded services related to child abuse and/or domestic violence.
 - b. # people educated at training/outreach events.
 - c. # funding arrangements established to sustainably support services and/or regional coordination.
- **Shelagh Baird** – With # funding arrangements established to sustainably support services and/or regional coordination, what were you thinking and wanting?
 - a. **Paulina Kaiser** – Efforts around alternative payment model or service contract.

- b. **Sommer McLeish** – CAMI (Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Intervention) Fund and VOCA (Victims of Crime Act) Fund and look at these as financial means – Have not initiated yet. Not sure if the Coast to Cascades Community Wellness Network or partners are looking at. Listed in grant as sustainable deliverable. They are funding opportunities that can support our partners with direct service for victims of violence (VOCA) and fund teams to deal with child abuse (CAMI).
 - c. **Paulina Kaiser** – Funding arrangements – More complicated – With sustainability and Network and regional alignment. Can work further on this.
- **Shelagh Baird** – Look at how to collect enough data to make it meaningful.
- **Jolynn Meza Wynkoop** – When looking at # people receiving grant-funded services, do they collect individuals served at partner organizations and do they receive funding for staff? Sometimes we just report on the grant and other stuff going on in the organization.
 - a. **Sommer McLeish** – Gets a monthly report from partners and updates the Work Plan. Her position is paid through the grant.
 - b. **Jolynn Meza Wynkoop** – Would be number of people serving.
- **Jolynn Meza Wynkoop** – Do you need more measures or is 3 measures okay?
 - a. **Paulina Kaiser** – 2-3 measures are good. Make sure when figuring out what to count see if it is useful to collect each year.
- **Shelagh Baird** – Every year the sustainability piece is important. Need to record we made an impact and can continue without HRSA funding. Can we change measures each year?
- **Jolynn Meza Wynkoop** - # funding arrangements established to sustainably support services and/or regional coordination – With opioid grant – Look at how many grants they receive for substance use disorder (SUD) services and provide a baseline. Ask partners how many funding streams they receive and track over the years of the grant. This is how she interprets that question.
 - a. **Paulina Kaiser** – Good idea! Also, agrees with Shelagh Baird on the sustainability piece and recording we made an impact and how to continue without HRSA funding. Does not expect to report for Year 1 funding arrangements. Will still include. Recognizes the importance and no established agreement to report in Year 1. Can ask for a more descriptive narrative on measures we choose.
- **Shelagh Baird** – Is key informant interviews part of the process with quantitative and qualitative data?
 - a. **Paulina Kaiser** – Both contribute to overall plan – Quantitative portion – Dashboard. The evaluation is designed with overall mixed methods.
- **Paulina Kaiser** – Hears agreement on the measures. Will flush out # funding arrangements established to sustainably support services and/or regional coordination. *Will collaborate further with Sommer McLeish on the Evaluation.*
