Welcome:

Dr. Jeannie Davis welcomed everyone to the meeting and led introductions.

Meeting Minutes:

The June 11, 2024, meeting minutes of Linn, Benton, Lincoln Partners for Health were presented. **Sommer McLeish made a motion and Shelagh Baird seconded to approve the June 11, 2024, meeting minutes as presented. The motion was voted upon and was unanimously approved.**

Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Grant - Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities:

Sommer McLeish reported on the Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities Grant.

- Have submitted the Evaluation Plan and Data Dashboard that is part of the grant to HRSA at the end of June 2024.
- Year 2 of the grant started July 1, 2024.
- All contracts have been signed.
- Working on an “action plan” specifically for Lincoln County. Luis Acosta is taking on. Looking at information gathered and how to support folks in the county and use as guidance for the remainder of the grant.
- Working on the Performance Improvement Measurement System (PIMS) report, another deliverable of the grant that is due at the end of the month. The first draft is close to being ready.
- This Thursday, a subcommittee will meet regarding the marketing/media campaign that will be focused on Lincoln and rural Linn Counties. The subcommittee will meet the 2nd Thursday of each month starting on July 11, 2024. We are looking for those who have experience with victims and survivors of violence to help guide the messaging for our community members.

2024 Linn, Benton, Lincoln Partners for Health Summit:

Discussion focused around the 2024 Partners for Health Summit.

- Date for the event – August 23, 2024.
- **Title** - *Communities Supporting Youth Together*.
- **Location** - LBCC Chinook Hall – Corvallis. We will be doing a tour of the facility on July 24, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. if anyone is interested in attending.
- This will be an in-person event.
- An AV Tech will be available the day of the event.
- **Keynote Speaker** – Dr. Max Derenoncourt is unable to attend the summit so the new keynote speaker will be Mandilin Hudson, D.O., Site Dean, Assistant Professor of Behavioral Medicine and Psychiatry, Western University of Health Sciences-Lebanon.

- **Food:**
 - a. Lunch - Ron Island Grill out of Eugene will provide catering for lunch. Jolynn Meza Wynkoop has been organizing.
 - b. Breakfast – *Shelagh Baird will pick up breakfast type items and bottled water from Costco and arrange for coffee/tea service.*

- **Thien Nguyen** – Oregon Emergency Management has agreed to be a workshop presenter, so we have all workshop speakers.
- We can have 13 resource tables.
- Acosta Services will provide interpretation.
- **Luis Acosta** – Is Casa Latinos Unidos doing the Spanish workshop?
 - a. **Thien Nguyen** – They will be the single presenter for the Spanish workshop. We have not heard back from Movimiento Estudiantil Chicano de Aztlán (MECHA).
 - b. **Luis Acosta** – Is Casa Latinos Unidos confirmed for sure?
 - c. **Thien Nguyen** – *Will be following up with them to make sure they are confirmed for sure.*
- We need someone to do the introduction and closing.
 - a. **Dr. Jeannie Davis** – Can provide the introduction and closing.
- We have 56 people signed up for the summit to date.

Additional Business:

Additional business was noted.

- **Dr. Jeannie Davis:**
 - a. Has her Medical students at Western University of Health Sciences in Lebanon that do community service-learning outreach projects in the community and focus around areas identified in the community needs assessments.
 - b. **Jolynn Meza Wynkoop** – Would be great if we could have medical students share information about their projects with Partners for Health at a future meeting.
 - c. **Carolyn Black** – How old are the students? Would it be helpful to provide an information session to the students about Marketplace and the nuances so if they are faced with patients without coverage, they could direct them?
 - d. **Dr. Jeannie Davis** – *Can follow up with Carolyn Black.*
 - e. The average age of the students is around 27.
 - f. Hosted a 4-day summer camp for high school youth. They had 15 students attend.
- **Stephanie Miller** – Do not have a community outreach advocate yet.
