Welcome:

Dr. Jeannie Davis welcomed everyone to the meeting and led introductions.

Meeting Minutes:

The May 14, 2024, meeting minutes of Linn, Benton, Lincoln Partners for Health were presented. **Sommer McLeish made a motion and Georgia Smith seconded to approve the meeting minutes as presented. The motion was voted upon and was unanimously approved.**

Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Grant - Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities:

Sommer McLeish reported on the Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities Grant.

- The Violence Prevention Summit was held on May 17, 2024. We received so many positive comments regarding the summit. Even the resource rooms and tables, people enjoyed and were appreciative to be able to pop in and out of the room during the summit. 75 people had signed up for the summit and more than 60 people were in attendance.
 - a. Starting a planning committee for next years event, which will be held in Lincoln County on May 23, 2025, and we are looking at holding at the Casino.
 - b. AHM Brands out of Eugene attended and interviewed different attendees during this year's summit in preparation for the media campaign. They expressed that it was not like a dark day from the topics discussed and felt the summit was a day of hope and felt energized with facts, hope, and action.
- Media campaign – As noted, working with AHM Brands. Want to focus on reaching survivors/victims and use more social media. For the first year, will focus on things happening and with the second year will do more education and outreach and resources with a focus on survivors as well.
- Lincoln County – Did a final event on May 23, 2024, with Luis Acosta and Acosta Services with a dinner for the Mam community to help with completing the survey. Did different focus groups.
- Working with ABC House with providing counseling services – Working on contract.
- Working with Center Against Rape and Domestic Violence (CARDV) and focusing on outreaching and networking in rural areas. Will continue with middle school and high school curriculum in Year 2 of the grant.
- Discussed the evaluation and dashboard for the grant at the last meeting of this group. Dr. Paulina Kaiser is completing this week.
- Had our site visit with the Technical Advisors (TA's) with our grants May 15-17, 2024. Utilized their expertise on May 15, 2024, during our Coast to the Cascades Community Wellness Network (CCCWN) meeting in helping develop a Strategic Plan. They also toured some of our partners agencies during their visit.
 - a. They were impressed with ABC House and Sarah's Place.

- b. They noted the level of commitment, dedication, and togetherness of the partner to improve our communities.
- c. **Shelagh Baird** – Was on a call earlier with the TA and Project Officer and they were impressed and loved the visit. They also liked the highlight of all the reports at the CCCWN meeting on May 15, 2024, and want Rebecca Bender to come to Washington, DC and provide training.
- **Dr. Jeannie Davis** – Heard good comments regarding the Violence Prevention Summit.

Update – National Rural Health Association Health Equity Conference:

Dr. Jeannie Davis provided an update on the National Rural Health Association Health Equity Conference that she recently attended in May.

- Was part of a panel presentation at the National conference in early May at New Orleans, LA. Focused on how the community works together for the help of the community. Tied in the CCCWN and health and wellness. Discussed medical students and being the workforce and the need to learn. Discussed the importance of tying in medical education into the community. The communities look at all of us in helping develop community health and health education. There were many questions and with having the tri-county area (Benton, Lincoln, and Linn Counties) it was innovative and people were curious how we collaborate with everyone.
- It was a great conference with wonderful information.
- The presenters were great.
- There was valuable information on community collection.
- Hope to get more engagement with the Physical Therapy portion of the college as well.

 - a. In August, Western University of Health Sciences in Lebanon - We will have the medical student class of 2028. Students are required to do 30 hours per student in 2 years for community outreach projects.
 - b. AHEC will be hosting a 4-day summer camp for high school youth. They have 10 students, not just from this region. It will be June 24, 2024 – June 27, 2024, and be held on the Western University of Health Sciences on the Lebanon campus. This is the first time they have hosted in the building for high school youth.
 - c. The medical students are still doing nutrition classes through a grant with Linn County with Crossroads Community in Lebanon.
 - d. This Thursday will be doing a Tasting Table with kale smoothies at the Farmer’s Market in Lebanon. She will be there along with some medical students.
