**Welcome:**

Dr. Jeannie Davis welcomed everyone to the meeting and led introductions.

**Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Grant - Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities:**

Sommer McLeish reported on the Addressing Violence in Rural Oregon Communities Grant.

- The Violence Prevention Summit is scheduled for May 17, 2024.
  - a. The Summit will start at 8:30 a.m. with breakfast and training starting at 9:00 a.m. and going until 3:00 p.m.
  - b. The keynote speaker is Rebecca Bender.
  - c. It is free and open to anyone.
  - d. Luis Acosta and Acosta Services will be at the event and provide interpretation services.
  - e. There will be three sessions, a resource room, and a panel.
  - f. Will use Eventbrite for registration.
  - g. Will provide breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack.
  - h. There are still slots open for anyone that would like to attend.
  - i. The event will be held at Best Western Premier Boulder Falls Inn in Lebanon.
  - j. Other communities in rural Oregon have expressed interest in attending.
  - k. AHM Brands out of Eugene will be there at the start of the summit. They are helping with the Marketing campaign and will discuss and gather information. They are building a survey and will be interviewing folks to see what they would like to have as part of the campaign.
- Luis Acosta has completed the second focus group in Lincoln County. On April 25, 2024, it will be the third one at the Center for Health Education. He has offered free Zumba class and resources as well. It has been great to have Luis Acosta help with the classes and provide information.
- Completed the NCC report that was due with the grant, and it has been submitted on time. Will be updating the Progress Report as well. Expect that everything will be fine with funding.
- Will also be completing an evaluation. This will need to be completed by June. Paulina Kaiser will be invited to the next meeting to talk about this.
- Working with ABC House (direct services) and CARDV (navigation services) and working to get curriculum in the middle and high schools.

- **Deb Fell-Carlson** – Can we spell out the acronyms on the agenda?
  - a. *Members present agreed to spell out the acronyms.*
  - b. **Shelley Hazelton** – This is what the following acronyms stand for:
    - PAADA – Partnership Against Alcohol and Drug Abuse
    - CTSI – Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians
    - CEDARR – Community Efforts Demonstrating an Ability to Rebuild and Restore
    - **Edelyn Solis** – MECHA - Movimiento Estudiantil Chicanx de Aztlán
    - IMPACT – Individual Movement and Physical Activity for Children Today
    - STAND – Students Taking Action Not Drinking
- **Edelyn Solis** – MECHA is a student movement with South Albany High School. They held a big presence at the Festival Latino event with ethnic appropriate food, outfits/dress showing traditional culture. There was music and a celebration of Latino culture.
- Dr. Jeannie Davis shared the budget for the summit. There is a little over \$9,000 for the summit COMP-NW and SHS Community Health Promotion Department has put some funding into the summit and Oregon Health Authority Oregon Health Insurance Marketplace has also provided some funding as well. There would be a balance left over. We do not have to pay for the location so hopefully we would have more in the budget to help with other things.
- A continental type of breakfast will be provided with items from Costco and coffee will be provided as well.
- Jolynn Meza Wynkoop is working on a lunch estimate from Ron Island Grill out of Eugene.
- Jolynn Meza Wynkoop will take care of registration through Eventbrite.
- **Sommer McLeish** – When people register for the event, they will state whether they need an interpreter.
- Luis Acosta and Acosta Services will provide interpretation services.
- *Members present agreed that the MECHA and Casa Latinos workshop should be in Spanish.*
- How many interpreters are needed?
  - a. **Luis Acosta** – Will provide 3 interpreters.
- Can we use funding to help with additional outreach to the Spanish community?
  - a. **Luis Acosta** – When outreaching to the Spanish community, it takes a lot of work. Besides the Spanish flyer and registration in Spanish, there needs to be phone calls, visiting people, etc. to let them know of the importance of attending. Acosta Services can provide this outreach service.
  - b. **Sommer McLeish** – We would need to follow up with JoAnn Miller to see if we can use additional funds to provide outreach to the Spanish community.
- **Beatriz Botello-Salgado** – What about funding for transportation? Can we arrange for public transportation or have tickets available?
  - a. **Luis Acosta** – Some organizations will rent a bus to take people to events. Maybe we can look at working in partnership with some organizations on transportation.
  - b. **Sommer McLeish** – This would be another thing we would need to discuss with JoAnn Miller.
